



### **Dr Tiziano Baccetti**

Dr Baccetti is Research Professor at the University of Florence, Italy, and the 'Thomas M. Graber Visiting Scholar', Department of Orthodontics and Pediatric Dentistry, School of Dentistry, The University of Michigan, USA. He is a Visiting Lecturer at Harvard School of Dental Medicine, Boston University, University of North Carolina, and Ohio State University.

He graduated *cum laude* in Dentistry (DDS) at the University of Florence, Italy, in 1989.

In 1996 he achieved his PhD degree in Dental Sciences at the same University.

He won the National Prize of the Italian Society of Orthodontics (SIDO) in 1996, the Henry Goldman Prize issued by the Italian Society of Periodontology in 2001, and the Research Award of The Angle Society in 2003. He has lectured at international congresses and symposia on orthodontics and dentofacial orthopedics in more than 30 different countries, and he will be the presenter of the Salzmänn Lecture at the AAO Meeting, Chicago 2011. He has published extensively (more than 150 articles in journals with an Impact Factor).

Dr Baccetti has previously been a Member of the Editorial Board of the European Journal of Orthodontics, and a reviewer for several international dental journals. He is Co-Editor of the Journal of Clinical Orthodontics.
