



### **Nina Samoylova**

Dr. Nina Samoylova is a member of Russian Professional Orthodontic Society, active member of the European Orthodontic Society (since 1995) and member of World Federation of Orthodontists. She graduated from Moscow Medical Stomatological Institute in 1979. Following four years practice as a general dentist she received special postgraduate training and her orthodontic Master Degree in 1986 at the Central Institute for Advanced Medical Studies in Moscow. After the Research Scholarship in Orthodontics (1987-1990) at the same Institute she defended the thesis on the “Diagnosis, facial growth analysis and multidisciplinary clinical management of the hypodontia cases”. In 1991 she was appointed Associate Professor at the Department of Orthodontics at the Russian Medical Academy for Postgraduate Education. Dr. Samoylova was the first young academician from Eastern European countries who benefit from the grant program of the EOS in 1994. She has published 75 scientific papers and lectured in Russia and internationally.
