Theodore Eliades graduated from the School of Dentistry, University of Athens (Greece) in 1990, and completed Master's and Orthodontic curricula at the Ohio State University in 1994. He earned a doctorate in orthopaedic biomaterials at the University of Athens, School of Medicine, and received a PhD in Biomaterials from the University in Manchester, UK. He is currently Associate Professor at the Department of Orthodontics, the Aristotle University in Thessaloniki. His research on the structural conformation mechanical properties of biomaterials has generated 70 articles and book chapters, as well as 4 textbooks.
