He is presently *Assistant Professor at the University of Florence, Italy*, and “*Thomas M. Graber Visiting Scholar*”, *Department of Orthodontics and Pediatric Dentistry, School of Dentistry, The University of Michigan, Ann Arbor*. He graduated *cum laude* in Dentistry (DDS) at the University of Florence, Italy, in 1989. He has served the Italian Army as Dental Officer in 1990. From 1996 he holds a PhD degree in Dental Sciences at the University of Florence, Italy. He has been the winner of the Prize for the Best Poster in Orthodontic Research (First Classified, shared with Dr. Franchi) issued by the Italian Society Of Orthodontics (SIDO), in 1994, and (Second Classified, shared with Dr. Franchi) in 1995. In 1996 he has won the *National Prize of the Italian Society Of Orthodontics (SIDO)* for the best scientific article. In 2001 Dr. Baccetti has been the recipient of the *Award of The Angle Society for Excellence in Orthodontic Research* for the best paper published on The Angle Orthodontist during the years 2001-2003. He has been *Speaker* at the Annual Sessions of the American Association of Orthodontists from 1997 through 2006. Dr. Baccetti is a member of the Club International de Morphologie Faciale, European Orthodontic Society (EOS), and World Federation of Orthodontists (W.F.O.). He serves on the editorial Board of the *European Journal of Orthodontics*.
