



Dr AMBROSINA MICHELOTTI

Dr Michelotti graduated in Dentistry (DDS) in 1984. In 1991 she was appointed as a specialist in orthodontics and in 2001 associate professor in Clinical Gnathology at the University of Naples. She is Director of the Master course on 'Orofacial pain and temporomandibular disorders' at the University of Naples Federico II. Her clinical interests are related to the treatment of temporomandibular disorders (TMD) and to orthodontic practice. She has authored or co-authored more than 130 papers published in national and international journals. She has also given numerous lectures at international congresses. Dr Michelotti's research interests are mainly focused on the basic physiology of the jaw muscles, on the etiology, diagnosis and management of TMD, and on the relationship between the jaw musculature and orthodontics.

Dr Michelotti is the president of the European Academy of Craniomandibular Disorders (2010), President elect of the Neuroscience group of IADR (2011); President elect of SIDA (società italiana di disfunzioni ed algie temporomandibolari; 2012-2013); former Secretary of the RDC/TMD Consortium at the International Association of Dental Research, Associate Editor of the European Journal of Oral Science, member of the Editorial Board of the Journal of Oral Rehabilitation, and referee of several national and international journals.
