Dr Vandevska-Radunovic received her DMD and MSc in orthodontics at the University “Kiril i Metodij” in Skopje, Former Republic of Macedonia. She continued her orthodontic training at the University of Bergen, Norway from 1990-1992, where she obtained her PhD in 1998. In 2000 she obtained the position of Associate Professor at the Department of Orthodontics, University of Oslo, Norway, where she became a full-time Professor in 2011. She is involved in the education and research activities of graduates, postgraduates and doctoral students, while still maintaining one day of private practice.

For six years she was a member of the Continuing Education Committee of the Norwegian Association of Orthodontists. She is a recipient of the Mobility Award for promising dental research and Research and Teaching Award of the Norwegian Dental Society. At present, she serves as Chairman of the Membership Committee of NEBEOP. Her main areas of interest are tissue reactions during orthodontic tooth movement and relapse, retention procedures and long-term outcome of orthodontic treatment.
