

**Guy Willems**

Professor Guy Willems is the Head of the Orthodontics Section of the Department of Dentistry, Oral Pathology and Maxillofacial Surgery and Program Director of the combined Master/Clinical Postgraduate Training Program in Orthodontics, both at the Katholieke Universiteit Leuven, Belgium. He graduated in Dentistry in 1988. In 1992 he received a PhD degree from the Katholieke Universiteit Leuven and graduated in Operative Dentistry in 1993. He completed his orthodontic training in 1996 and has been a staff member of the Orthodontics Section since 1997. He founded and has been the Program Director of the Master in Forensic Odontology since 2001. He has published in both the field of orthodontics and forensic odontology. His main interests of research and areas of expertise include among others orthodontic materials science, self-esteem related to orthodontic treatment, canine impaction and associated lateral incisor root resorption, tooth transplantation, educational research in orthodontics, dental age estimation and craniofacial reconstruction. He is Associate Editor of Forensic Science International and reviewer of several international journals.
